Dear Parents

The June Exams are here!

Dr Hennah Larkins and her team have made the effort to ensure that the exam papers and memorandums are of the highest quality.

The shipping of the papers will begin as scheduled from the **17 May 2010**. We are still on time.

Exam procedures

1. The exam papers are accompanied by their memorandums and are posted at no extra cost to you. **Parents are to handle the exams personally and protect the integrity of the papers.** Thus it is your responsibility! In the event where papers are marked on the same day as the exam, the memorandum can serve as an excellent resource with regard to future studies.
2. IT exams are not paper-based but can be found on the internet. IT exams are placed on the IT forum and parents must be aware of this fact so as to protect the integrity of the exams. It is your responsibility! The subject IT cannot be taken unless your child has access to the internet.
3. The attached Control Form must be thoroughly compared to the exam paper and memorandum before your child starts with the examination.
4. The marking of the papers:
 - a. **Gr. 0 – 3** Answer sheets are to be sent in for marking, in order for you to receive a professional commentary as to the progress and development of your child.
 - b. **Gr. 4 – 11** Parents and centres are to mark the papers themselves as per the memorandums. Papers can be sent in for marking and assessment in the event where parents feel uncomfortable with the marking of exams.
 - c. **Gr. 12** The marking of papers and the sending up of the completed mark sheets can be done by yourselves. Papers can be sent in for marking and assessment in the event where parents feel uncomfortable with the marking of exams. Delta will return the assessed exam papers via your self addressed envelop with sufficient postage. The assessed exam papers must be filed in the portfolio file. This is your responsibility!
 - d. Mark sheets for the March test cycle and June Exam must be in at Delta before or on the **2nd of July** and we will strive to ensure that rappsports are available as of the **28th of July**.
 - e. Mark sheets accompanying exam papers must be completed and sent to Delta. Mark sheets can be sent via e-mail to rapport@impakonderwys.co.za or faxed to 0865568589.
 - f. In cases where exam papers are sent in to Delta for marking, please use registered post to ensure that the papers reach Delta.
 - g. In the case where parents wish for the papers to be returned please ensure that there is a self addressed envelope with sufficient postage. For clients beyond SA borders marked papers must be requested in writing furthermore they must grant permission to Delta to be invoiced for the postage.
 - h. Complimentary subjects are not examinable.
 - i. The following appears on the mark sheets (Gr. 4 – 11):
 - i. March average: All open book tests and the March cycle test
 - ii. June average: All open book tests and assignments for the 2nd term
 - iii. June exam: The June exam mark as marked by yourselves or externally marked by Delta.
 - j. With regard to Gr. 12 mark sheets the parent must only fill in the March test and June exam marks.

- k. Parents and centres must please make and keep a copy of their mark sheets before posting for future use at the next exam block.

With regard to assignments

- l. Gr. 0 – 11 All assignments are marked by yourselves, at home, you only need to send in the completed mark sheet. The assignments must be kept and maybe requested by Delta at anytime for external control and moderation.
- m. Gr. 12 Assignments are marked by yourselves and mark sheets are forwarded. The assignments must be kept in the portfolio file and can be requested at anytime by Delta for external control and moderation.
- n. All Gr. 10 – 12 Life Orientation assignments must be sent directly to the subject manager at Delta.
